she always sought you and how to serve you best.


Through her married love she became a sign of your love

The Novena at the Shrine of Saint Gianna Beretta Molla

The Novena of St. Gianna Beretta Molla consists of the participation in nine consecutive Tuesday masses in which particular prayers of petition and thanksgiving are offered to God. *(The nine recall the nine days that the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary spent in prayer between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost Sunday. While the word novena comes from the Latin novem, meaning "nine," the term has also come to be used generically to refer to any lengthy series of prayers.)* The Novena is also supported by daily prayer and reflection.
